


Binatone 2100 ADSL Router – Quickstart Guide

Setting up your router with a single IP address with Network Address Translation (NAT) for IP sharing.

This guide should be used in conjunction with the setup guide you have received with your router. This setup guide will apply to any operating system, although for operating system specific information you should refer to the router setup guide.

- 1 First of all you will need to set up the Network card on your computer. This should be configured to get its IP address automatically by DHCP. For Windows operating systems, full details on how to make these changes are available on pages 12&13 of the setup guide provided with the router. For other operating systems please refer to your help files.
- 2 Connect the router to a telephone line splitter using the telephone connection lead (supplied). Connect your router to the mains power supply using the included adaptor and switch on the router. Connect your PC directly to the router using the supplied (straight through) Ethernet cable.
- 3 Type <http://192.168.1.2/> into the address field of your browser. You will be asked to enter a username. Enter **admin** as the username and leave the password field **blank**. You should now be presented with the “**Login Settings**” screen of the web management screens. Note that if you cannot see the configuration page shown below you should click the “**Login Settings**” link in the menu on the left.



- 4 You will need to enter the following technical settings to connect to your ADSL. If any settings are not specified here please leave them at the default value.

Your broadband username is different to the username you choose during registration. Check the table below to find out yours. It is also sent to you by email when your broadband is activated.

In the **Password** box enter the password you chose when signing up for your broadband account. Once the details have been entered click on the “**Connect**” button.

- 5 After a pause you should be prompted with “**You have successfully connected to the internet**”. Click **OK** to finish the setup process. Congratulations - your Router Starter Pack is now connected to your new Broadband account.
- 6 Please be aware that to connect multiple computers to the router once it is setup you should simply apply step 1 to each computer that you wish to connect and plug them into a free port with another Ethernet cable. If you wish to connect more than 4 computers to the router then please refer to the router setup guide for advice on connecting either a hub or a switch.
